Borrowing Regulations

1. Please read the Borrowing Regulations and return the completed application form to Tobacco Control Office by fax or mail.
2. Except by special arrangement, the exhibition boards can be borrowed for up to two weeks.
3. Upon receiving completed application form, borrower will be contacted for confirmed borrowing period and the date of collecting exhibition boards and display panel. The venue of collection is **Flat 1, Upper Ground Floor, Kwun Tong Jockey Club Health Centre, 457 Kwun Tong Road, Kwun Tong, Kowloon**. No collection service will be arranged on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.
4. Borrower should present the original copy of application form when he/she collect for the exhibition boards and display panel.
5. The borrowed materials should only be used for non-profit purposes.
6. Borrower should bear all responsibilities and charges incurred due to any damages and/or loss of the borrowed materials.
7. Borrower is required to return all the borrowed materials on due date with no damage.
8. Each organization should only borrow one set of exhibition boards at each time.

The exhibition boards are organized into four columns and three rows. Each board features the Tobacco Control Office logo and a 'No Smoking' sign. The content includes:

- Column 1:**
 - Board 1: Introduction to the 2006 Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance, its purpose, and key provisions.
 - Board 2: Designated No Smoking Areas (NSMAs), listing various locations like public buildings, government premises, and public places.
 - Board 3: Enforcement of the Ordinance, detailing the roles of police officers and tobacco control inspectors.
- Column 2:**
 - Board 4: Smoking Cessation Services, providing information on quit lines, support groups, and cessation tips.
 - Board 5: Hazards of Smoking and Secondhand Smoke, explaining the health risks of both.
- Column 3:**
 - Board 6: Designated No Smoking Areas (continued), showing various NSMA locations with photos.
 - Board 7: Smoking Cessation Services (continued), featuring 'Quit Tips' and support resources.
 - Board 8: Hazards of Smoking and Secondhand Smoke (continued), including a 'Skull and Crossbones' warning sign.
- Column 4:**
 - Board 9: Designated No Smoking Areas (continued), showing more NSMA examples.
 - Board 10: Smoking Cessation Services (continued), with more cessation tips.
 - Board 11: Hazards of Smoking and Secondhand Smoke (continued), with a 'Skull and Crossbones' warning sign.
